A soon-to-be-opened street level, downtown, private / public, contemporary space for emerging artists from Muskoka, to interact, display, promote and sell their work.



A space focused on engaging and empowering youth through interaction, display, mentorship and public viewing within the context of modern culture and technology.

Located within the historic "Queen's Hotel," circa 1885, Six Degrees Muskoka is a fluid, free, contemporary, private / public venue, with a structure and focus on culture and youth, designed to evolve, grow and reflect today.

"Six Degrees of Separation:" a belief that all people, and by extension, cultural, artistic, scientific or even economic assets, are closely interrelated with that relationship often unobserved.

Through Six Degrees Muskoka, our local community will be better equipped to explore, and thus understand our commonalities and manage our differences.

Three touchstones within the space:

- * A 10 seat digital studio, offering an introduction to computer animation and software.
- * A display and retail space with a rotating content of contemporary and traditional works of art.
- * A collection of approximately 4,000 books on art, architecture, science and nature.
